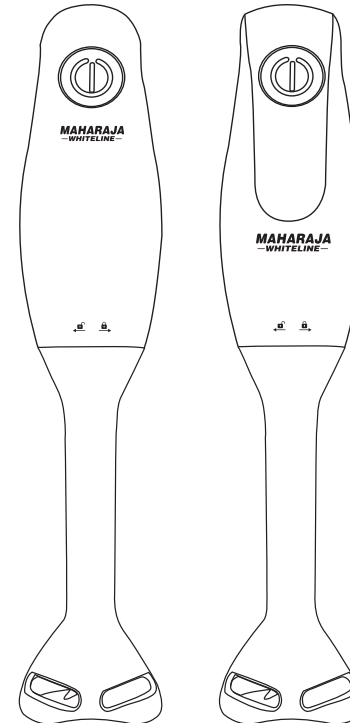

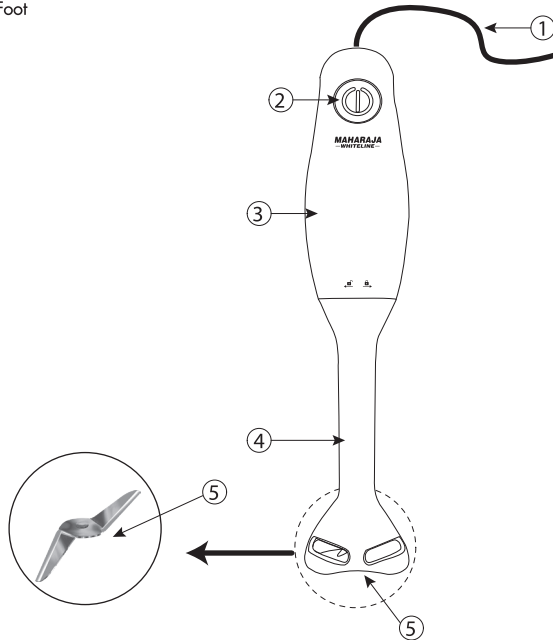

FIRST USE

Read all the instructions carefully and keep them for future reference.
 Remove the appliance from its packaging. Keep away from children.
 Before using the appliance for the first time, check that the voltage shown on the device label corresponds to the voltage in the mains.
 Hold motor housing firm and detach the blender from motor housing by rotating it.
 Clean the motor housing with a sponge or a cloth dampened in warm water.
 Clean blender with warm water and washing up liquid.
 Place the hand blender on an even surface at a safe distance away from flammable objects.
 Keep out of the reach of children.

NOTE:

A slight smell may be noticeable when the hand mixer is used for the first time. This is normal and will disappear after a short while.

ASSEMBLY/ DISASSEMBLY

When attaching accessories there is the risk of pinching your fingers. Please be especially careful.

Attach the motor housing (3) on the plastic foot (4) by observing the recesses on the blender.

Rotate the motor housing rotate in a clockwise direction until it “clicks” into position. Motor casing and metal foot should be tightly connected.

Rotate the metal foot anticlockwise in order to disconnect it from motor housing. Remove the metal foot.

SAFETY INSTRUCTIONS

Check that the voltage of your appliance indicated on its rating plate matches that of your electrical installation.

Any incorrect connection invalidates the warranty.

- Always unplug the appliance from the electrical power supply if it is left unattended and when removing accessories or carrying out maintenance. This appliance is not intended for use by persons (including children) with reduced physical, sensory or mental capacities, or lack of experience and knowledge, unless they have been given supervision or instruction concerning use of the appliance by a person responsible for their safety. Children should be supervised to ensure that they do not play with the appliance.
- Do not touch the blade of the mixer attachment when the appliance is plugged In. Ensure that any ties, scarves and long hair do not come into contact with any moving parts of the appliance.
- Do not operate the mixer attachment when empty.
- Do not operate the mixer attachment with dry ingredients (walnuts ,hazelnuts).
- Do not pull on the power cord to unplug it.
- Children should be supervised to ensure that they do not play with the blender.
- Do not touch the moving parts.
- Do not dismantle the appliance yourself. Simply carry out the usual care and cleaning steps as advised.
- For your safety, use only accessories and spare parts designed for your appliance.
- Care must be taken when handling sharp blades, emptying the bowl or cleaning.

Changing the power cord

If the power cord or the plug is damaged, do not use the appliance. In order to avoid any danger, have them replaced by an approved Maharaja Sevice Centre. This product has been designed for domestic use only. Any commercial use, inappropriate use or failure to comply with the instructions, the manufacturer accepts no responsibility and the guarantee will not apply.

CLEANING

Always unplug the appliance from the electrical power supply before cleaning.

- Do not immerse the motor unit and Cover in water. Wipe it with a dry or slightly damp cloth.
- All of the accessories, except motor unit and Cover, can be washed in hot water or the dishwasher.
- Be careful when cleaning the blades, as they are very sharp.

WARRANTY TERMS AND CONDITIONS

GROUPE SEB INDIA PVT LIMITED (“Company”) warrants that the Company shall rectify any manufacturing defect in the Hand blender (“Product”), carry out such repair/replacement (as the case may be) free of charge during the warranty period of 2 (two) years. The Company shall in no event be replacing the product as a part of warranty unless and until there is an irreparable manufacturing defect in the product as decided by the technical team of the Company.

The period of availing warranty shall commence from the date of purchase as mentioned on the valid tax invoice or on Warranty card duly filled, signed & stamped by authorised dealer of the Company. The Company is not required to provide any services pertaining to the product after the expiry of said warranty period.

TERMS AND CONDITIONS OF WARRANTY:

1. This warranty shall be valid only if the product shall be used only as per the guidelines provided in this instruction manual. The product is to be used only for domestic purpose and not for any commercial, rental or profit generating activities.
2. This warranty can only be availed by the first purchaser of the product and is not transferable and non-assignable.
3. The Customer is required to register the complaint with the Customer Care Centre of the Company by way of phone call, email or whatsapp chatbot.
4. The customer must present the valid warranty card or the valid tax invoice as a pre-condition before availing the warranty for the product as well as any related spares in the absence of which the Company may refuse to provide any warranty services.
5. Any repair or replacement done on the Product or any parts of the product during the warranty period, will in no event extend the Warranty period. The Warranty period is limited as provided herein, irrespective of the period of the product was not in use, was not giving proper performance, was under breakdown or was under repair by Company’s authorised service centre.
6. The Company/its Authorised Service Centre reserves the right to retain any part/component/product replaced. The Company shall have exclusive right to replace the defective/unserviceable parts with the parts which may be new or refurbished free of charge during the warranty period.
7. Any repair or replacement carried out on the product or any part thereof by anyone other than authorised service centre, shall make this warranty void.
8. The Company shall provide Door-step service during the Warranty period. However, if the Product is located outside the municipal limits and serviceable area of Company’s Authorised Service Centre, in such rare event the Company may refuse to provide Door-Step service and the Customer shall be required to bring the Product at the designated Service Centre of the Company or some other location within the municipal limits, at its own cost and expenses.
9. In case of any doubt regarding any conditions mentioned on this warranty card, including but not limited to authenticity of the Product, tax invoice, warranty card, part of the product etc, the decision of the Company shall be final and binding on the Customer.
10. The warranty is issued at New Delhi and courts at New Delhi shall have sole jurisdiction over matters covered or flowing from this warranty.
11. The Company shall not be liable for any indirect, special, consequential, special, incidental, punitive, exemplary or economical damage or loss. The Company’s liability under or in relation to this warranty shall be limited to the purchase price paid by the Customer as per valid tax invoice.

THIS WARRANTY IS NOT APPLICABLE IN ANY OF THE FOLLOWING CASES:

- 1) The signed & stamped warranty card or the tax invoice is not presented to the service personnel at the time of claiming or availing the warranty.
- 2) The product installation, use or maintenance is not done as per the instructions given in this instruction manual or as per common sense/understanding of usage of hand blender for such actions which are not specifically stated in this Instruction Manual.
- 3) If the original serial number of the Product is removed, tampered with or altered.
- 4) Violation of any warranty terms and conditions mentioned above.
